STEPS TO QUALIFY

HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

STEP 1: FIND YOUR SECTION

This guide is separated into three sections, based on your home's primary heating source. To qualify, your home must be primarily heated by one of the following:

- **Electricity from Puget Sound Energy (PSE):** RePower Bainbridge, RePower Bremerton and RePower Kitsap
- **Natural gas from Cascade Natural Gas Corporation*:** RePower Bremerton and RePower Kitsap
- **Oil or propane:** RePower Bainbridge, RePower Bremerton and RePower Kitsap

*Customers whose electricity is provided by PSE are also eligible to receive appliance incentives from PSE.

STEP 2: IDENTIFY YOUR REPOWER OFFER

Use these symbols to find your qualifying incentives:

- B** RePower Bremerton
- K** RePower Kitsap

HOME ENERGY ASSESSMENT WITH EPS: \$450



A Home Energy Assessment with EPS is performed by a participating Kitsap County Building Performance Institute (BPI)-certified contractor. Homeowners receive an Energy Performance Score (EPS)—a detailed energy-consumption report similar to a miles-per-gallon report for your home—which documents your home’s current condition and prioritized energy upgrades.

INCENTIVES

Attic: Incentive paid at 50% of installation cost, up to \$400.

Requirement—Current attic insulation must be R-11 or less; must insulate as close to R-49 as possible. Please note: Jobs must be completed by an independent contractor, pre-authorized by PSE. Only homes built prior to 1990 with electricity as the primary heat source qualify for duct sealing, insulation and Home Performance with ENERGY STAR® incentives.

Attic: Incentive paid at 50% of installation cost, up to \$200.

Requirement—Current attic insulation must be R-19 or less; must insulate as close to R-49 as possible. Please note: Jobs must be completed by an independent contractor, pre-authorized by PSE. Only homes built prior to 1990 with electricity as the primary heat source qualify for duct sealing, insulation and Home Performance with ENERGY STAR incentives.

Wall: Incentive paid at 50% of installation cost, up to \$400.

Requirement—Wall cavity must be empty; must use blow-in or batt insulation and insulate to R-13 or greater. Please note: Jobs must be completed by an independent contractor, pre-authorized by PSE. Only homes built prior to 1990 with electricity as the primary heat source qualify for duct sealing, insulation and Home Performance with ENERGY STAR incentives.

Floor: Incentive paid at 50% of installation cost, up to \$400.

Requirement—Current floor insulation must be less than four inches; must insulate to R-30 or fill joist cavity. Only homes built prior to 1990 with electricity as the primary heat source qualify for duct sealing, insulation and Home Performance with ENERGY STAR incentives.

Duct: Incentive paid at 50% of installation cost, up to \$500

Requirements—Current duct insulation must be one inch or less; must install to R-11 or greater and must be completed with duct sealing to qualify. Ducts must not be in extreme disrepair. At least 30% of ducts must be accessible from the exterior with no mastic present. No ducts in the basement shall be sealed. Please note: Jobs must be completed by an independent contractor, pre-authorized by PSE. Only homes built prior to 1990 with electricity as primary heat source qualify for duct sealing, insulation and Home Performance with ENERGY STAR incentives.

To upgrade existing duct sealing, all accessible ducts must be sealed and repaired with a maximum of three linear feet of duct replacement. Basement ducts do not qualify.

Windows incentives are paid at \$5 per sq. ft. of installed windows, up to \$750

Requirements—Windows must have a U-value of 0.30 or less. Windows must be installed by December 31, 2012. New windows must replace existing single-pane wood- or metal-framed windows –OR– double-pane, metal-framed windows. Home must meet minimum insulation requirements in the attic (at least six inches); wall (more than one inch) and floor (more than four inches). Incentive does not apply to new construction or additions which expand the home’s current square footage or cubic footage; nor does it apply to self-installed windows. One incentive per address.

Electric forced-air furnace to air-source heat pump conversion: \$1,500

Requirements—Must upgrade to an Air Conditioning, Heating and Refrigeration Institute (AHRI) performance-certified heat pump with a minimum efficiency of 8.5 Heating System Performance Factor (HSPF) and 14 Seasonal Energy Efficiency Ratio (SEER). Can only be combined with heat pump sizing and lock-out control incentive. Auxiliary heating sources do not qualify for additional incentives. Electric zonal customers are not eligible. Home cannot have an existing heat pump, ductless heat pump, gas furnace or gas boiler. Written pre-approval from PSE required. Visit pse.com/rebates to download the application.

Air-source heat pump (Tier 1): \$200

Requirements—Minimum 8.5 HSPF and minimum 14 SEER. Heat pump system must be AHRI certified. Can only be combined with heat pump sizing and lock-out control incentive. Auxiliary heating sources do not qualify for additional incentives.

Air-source heat pump (Tier 2): \$350

Requirements—Minimum 9.0 HSPF and minimum 14 SEER. Heat pump system must be AHRI certified. Can only be combined with heat pump sizing and lock-out control incentive. Auxiliary heating sources do not qualify for additional incentives.

Air-source heat pump (Tier 3): \$800

Requirements—Minimum 10.0 HSPF and minimum 16 SEER. Heat pump system must be AHRI certified. Can only be combined with heat pump sizing and lock-out control incentive. Auxiliary heating sources do not qualify for additional incentives.

Geothermal Heat Pump: 30% of cost.
Rentals do not qualify.

Air-source heat pump sizing and lock-out control: \$300

Requirements—Existing air-source heat pumps more than 12 years old are not eligible. Customers planning a new installation or submitting an existing installation must provide PSE-sizing documentation completed by a qualified contractor. Documentation must indicate the system is properly sized for the home and meets PSE requirements. Visit pse.com rebates for complete documentation details.

New air-source heat pumps must have 8.5 HSPF and 14 SEER. Lock-out control for auxiliary heat (electric or natural gas forced-air furnaces; propane furnaces are not eligible) must be set to 40° and have a sensor installed capable of reading outdoor temperature.

Resident must:

- Be an occupant in the home for the previous 12-month period
- Expect to occupy the home for an additional 24 months after installation
- Agree to share prior 12-month billing history
- Agree to share up to 24 months of billing history after installation

Incentive can only be combined with air-source heat pump incentive or forced-air furnace to heat pump conversion incentives.

Ductless heat pump: \$1,200

Requirements—Heat pump must be AHRI certified, use inverter technology and be a minimum one ton in heating mode. At least one ductless heat pump unit must be installed in the main living area of the home. Previous heating system must be electric zonal (such as baseboard, cable or wall heater), electric hydronic or electric forced-air furnace. Home cannot have an existing heat pump or natural gas service, even if only used for cooking. Cannot be combined with any other space heating incentive.

Geothermal heat pump: \$1,500

Requirements—Must install ENERGY STAR qualified equipment. Cannot have an existing geothermal heat pump. Auxiliary heating sources do not qualify for additional incentives.

Geothermal Heat Pump: 30% of cost.
Rentals do not qualify.

Heat pump water heater: \$500
 Requirements—Must be ENERGY STAR qualified and installed outside the conditioned living space (i.e. garage, attic or crawlspace).

Electric storage water heater: \$50
 Requirements— Must be 0.94 Energy Factor (EF) or greater and have a minimum rated capacity of 50 gallons. Indirect water heaters do not qualify.

Waste-water heat recovery system: \$250
 Requirements—Must currently heat water with an electric water heater. Equipment must be 42% EF and be installed vertically. Homemade systems and electric tankless water heaters are not eligible.

Refrigerator replacement: \$35

Requirements—Refrigerator must be 25% more energy efficient than ENERGY STAR standards and 7.75 cubic feet or larger. For a list of qualifying models, visit pse.com/appliances. This offer is separate from the refrigerator and freezer recycling incentive.

Refrigerator and freezer recycling: \$20

Requirements—You must own the refrigerator or freezer. Unit must be 10 – 32 cubic feet and in working order. Unit must be plugged in the night before pickup. Your unit will be picked up—at no charge—from the billing address listed on your account. You will receive a \$20 gift card by mail within four weeks after pick up. Limit of three units per household. Call 1.877.577.0510 to schedule pick-up.

Home Performance with ENERGY STAR: \$400

Requirements—Complete a Home Performance with ENERGY STAR test-in evaluation to document the home's needs and eligibility; test-out evaluation must be performed to document completed improvements and leave the home in safe operating condition. Test-in and test-out evaluations must be performed by a PSE-Qualified Specialist. Homeowner must also complete one PSE-qualified duct sealing incentive, one insulation incentive and an additional water heating, space heating or insulation incentive. Please note: Jobs must be completed by an independent contractor, pre-authorized by PSE. Only homes built prior to 1990 qualify for duct sealing, insulation and Home Performance with ENERGY STAR incentives.

Wall: Insulation incentives paid per sq. ft. of the installation area.

Requirement—Current insulation must be equal to or less than R-4; install to R-11 or greater. \$0.40 per

Floor: Insulation incentives paid per sq. ft. of the installation area.

Requirement—Current insulation must be equal to or less than R-11; install to R-30 or fill joist cavity. \$0.45 per sq. ft.

To be eligible for a Cascade Natural Gas Corporation rebate, insulation must be installed by a Cascade Natural Gas Corporation-qualified trade ally. Visit www.cngc.com/conservation to find a qualified trade ally.

Wall: Incentive paid at 50% of installation cost, up to \$400. Requirement—Wall cavity must be empty; must use blow-in or batt insulation and insulate to R-13 or greater. Wall insulation must be installed by a RePower trade ally.

Floor: Incentive paid at 50% of installation cost, up to \$400. Requirement—Current floor insulation must be four inches or less; must insulate to R-30 or fill joist cavity.

Duct: Incentive paid at 50% of installation cost, up to \$500. Requirements—Current duct insulation must be one inch or less; must install to R-11 or greater and be combined with duct sealing. Ducts must not be in extreme disrepair. More than 30% of ducts must be accessible from the exterior with no mastic present. No ducts in the basement shall be sealed. To upgrade existing duct sealing, all accessible ducts must be sealed and repaired with a maximum of three linear feet of duct replacement. Basement ducts do not qualify. Duct insulation must be installed by a RePower trade ally. Ducts must be tested and sealed to PTCS standards before and after insulation is installed.

Combination tankless water heater: \$800

Requirements—Minimum 90% AFUE and serve as primary space- and domestic- water heating source. Must be installed by a RePower trade ally.

Receive a \$400 RePower Reward when you install two qualifying improvements. Visit RePowerBremerton.org or RePowerKitsap.org to download terms & conditions. Only one RePower Reward redeemable per household.

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STEPS TO QUALIFY FOR PSE INCENTIVES

Homes primarily heated with electricity from PSE.

1. Meet PSE qualifications—Duct sealing and insulation jobs must be completed by an independent contractor, pre-authorized by PSE. Only homes built prior to 1990 qualify for duct sealing, insulation and Home Performance with ENERGY STAR incentives. All jobs must be installed in 2012. Only one incentive per qualifying electricity meter.

2. Prepare your home—All PSE customers who receive incentives automatically agree to periodic inspection by PSE.

3. Submit application—Incentive applications must be submitted within 30 days of completed installation. Visit the Savings and Energy Center page at pse.com to download your applications.



STEPS TO QUALIFY FOR CASCADE NATURAL GAS CORPORATION INCENTIVES

Homes primarily heated with gas from Cascade Natural Gas Corporation.

1. Download and complete incentive application from the Conservation page at cngc.com.

2. Include contractor invoice—All incentive applications must be submitted with a copy of the contractor's invoice marked paid in full.

3. Submit application—All incentive applications must be postmarked and submitted within 90 days of completed installation.



STEPS TO QUALIFY FOR REPOWER INCENTIVES

Homes primarily heated by oil or propane.

1. Download and complete incentive application—All incentive applications must be signed by the trade ally contractor and homeowner. Download your application from a RePower website.

2. Include contractor invoice—All incentive applications must be submitted with a copy of the contractor's invoice marked paid in full.

3. Submit application—All incentive applications must be received by RePower within 90 days of the completed installation. Mail incentive applications and documentation to:

STEPS TO QUALIFY FOR FEDERAL TAX CREDITS

Federal tax credits also help offset the out-of-pocket costs for qualifying energy-efficiency improvements. Federal tax credits are in addition to RePower or utility incentives. Other requirements include:

- 1. Jobs must be installed in 2012, unless otherwise noted**—Save your receipts and manufacturer's certificate(s) for your tax records.
- 2. Submit Form 5695 with your taxes**—by April 15, 2013.
- 3. Claim your Residential Energy Tax Credits on Form 1040**—on by April 15, 2013.

Actual cost savings are based on the size and condition of the home. RePower Rewards are paid one time per household. All incentives expire December 31, 2012, are subject to availability and may change. Encourage your contractor to review RePower's Weatherization Specifications Manual for installation requirements before performing work in your home.*
